## ANOTHER BANNER YEAR FOR NDP Boys golf wins first state championship!

The boys golf team won their first state championship. It is the first state championship for a boys program in NDP school history! They scored 316 on day one and were up by 7 strokes. They scored 318 on day two for a total of 634 and topped second place Haslett by 3 strokes. Matt Sheperd placed 6th in the individual standings with scores of 75 on day one and 77 on day two for a total of 152. Brendan Hanley, Nick Shermetaro, Aaron Knutson and Mike Klieman were the other members of the state championship lineup.



Girls soccer shutout Richmond 4-0 in the regional semifinal, handing them only their second loss of the season. Emily Gray led the scoring with two goals and Celia Horak and Paige Aiello each had one. Emily Anderson had six saves in goal. They advanced to the Elite 8 where they fell to Country Day 1-0 on a late goal and were eliminated from the state tournament. The Irish finished the season with an impressive record of 17-6-1.



Softball fell to Richmond 9-6 in the regional semifinal. Sarah Dulapa went 2-4 with 2 RBI. Kara Dal Bianco struck out 5 batters in seven innings, allowing only 2 earned runs and also drove in 2 runs.
