NDP students are sought after by top colleges and universities. Here are 10 facts to prove it:

1. Notre Dame students were accepted to 135 colleges and universities in 2011.
2. All members of the Class of 2011 were accepted to a four-year college or university.
3. Every NDP graduate over the last 14 years has been accepted to a four-year college or university.
4. Sixty-four percent of the Class of 2011 earned an academic scholarship to college.
5. The 160 students in the Class of 2011 earned nearly 300 scholarships.
6. The Class of 2011 earned scholarships to 20 Catholic colleges and universities.
7. The Class of 2011 earned nearly \$12 million in merit-based scholarships.
8. Thirty-seven students in the Class of 2011 gained acceptance to the University of Michigan.
9. Eight students in the Class of 2011 gained acceptance to the University of Notre Dame.
10. Ten students from the Class of 2011 signed to play college athletics.
