## 2019-2020 RE-ENROLLMENT CHECKLIST

1. Sign and return your enrollment agreement before Friday, February 1 by visiting the Go Irish! webpage at <[www.ndpma.org/GoIrish](http://www.ndpma.org/GoIrish)>;
2. Update your student(s) demographic information;
3. Complete the FAST (Financial Aid for School Tuition) application if you wish to request assistance;
4. Complete the Tuition Assurance Request at the same time you submit your agreement if you wish to purchase it;
5. Pay in full before Monday, February 11 to receive a 1 percent discount. Email the business office at <[billing@ndpma.org](mailto:billing@ndpma.org)> on before February 1 to learn your exact amount;
6. Return the bus route survey if your son or daughter needs transportation next year;
7. Register to attend a parent information session hosted on January 17, January 22 or January 30 if you would like more information about continuous enrollment.
