

ATHLETIC PROGRAM HIGHLIGHTS

- Boys lacrosse advanced to the state semifinal where they fell to Detroit Country Day 8-5. Their final season record was 18-4.
- Sarah Barron won the 800 Meter Run state championship at the MHSAA Division 2 Track and Field finals with a time of 2:13.49. She broke 5 school records in running (5K, 800 Meter Run, 1600 Meter Run, 3200 Meter Run, 1600 Meter Relay) and now holds six total cross country and track school records.
- Competitive cheer had their best season in school history, finishing third at the MHSAA Division 3 state finals. They qualified for the finals for the first time in 2009 and finished eighth out of eight teams in 2010. They broke school records in all three rounds and total score throughout the season.
- Boys and girls lacrosse both defended their CHSL championship and division titles. The
 boys have won four straight CHSL championships and division titles while the girls have
 won three straight CHSL championships and four straight division titles.
- Girls swimming and diving had their best finish in school history at the state finals, scoring 81 points. Three school records were set, including Kaleigh Mullen in the 500 Free, the 400 Free relay and the 200 Free relay. Marin McInerney finished seventh in the 100 Back, earning first team all state honors. The 400 Free relay also earned first team all state honors.
- Volleyball won their 13th district title (they have now won four straight) and 11th CHSL division title in school history.
- Softball won their ninth district title in school history (they have now won five straight).
- Boys basketball won their seventh district title in school history (they have now won four straight). Girls basketball won their fifth district title in school history.
- Competitive cheer and baseball had the highest GPAs in the state for their divisions. Eleven NDP teams earned Academic All State honors.
- School records in sprinting events were broken in boys track and field for the first time since 2005. Jacob Romeo broke the 100 Meter Dash record. The 400 Meter Relay and 800 Meter Relay records were also broken.
- Girls ski and girls tennis both qualified as teams to compete at their respective state finals.
- Notre Dame Marist JV boys basketball won a CYO division championship.
- Notre Dame Marist boys track and field broke school records in four events. Eric Leduc was the CYO champion in the boys shot put with a new school record throw and Andrea Pangori was the CYO champion in girls high jump with a new school record jump.
